Corvette Museum Sinkhole

The National Corvette Museum, in Bowling Green KY, suffered a substantial loss as a 40-foot-wide, 25 to 30-feet-deep sinkhole opened up and swallowed eight corvettes in the facility's yellow Sky Dome wing causing millions of dollars in damage. Motion detectors first alerted security shortly after 5:30 a.m. on February 12, 2014. The news was a shock for all, especially to the Corvette Nation.

The eight corvettes that were damaged were

The buzz during the car shows last year was that most of the shows had fewer participants than previous years. The ageing demographics of Corvette owners is a major factor for the reduction of participants in all Corvette car shows.

The other reason given by many WSCC members is that they believe judging in its present form is unfair. Those complaining reasoned that the whole car cannot be reasonably and accurately rated by each judge within the five minutes per car allocated.



The W.S.C.C. competition committee have made changes for the 2014 season they believe will make showing our cars more enjoyable.

The "Park and Show" will have three judges per car. Each judge will only rate one aspect of the car... tires, or exterior, or interior.

The "Park and Show" will have no class breakdown. i.e. Stock, Modified, Custom, etc.

The Car Show will have four judges per car. Each judge will only rate one aspect of the car... tires, or exterior, or engine, or interior.

The judges may now confer with each other to ask questions they might have concerning what might be an appropriate deduction.

Points deductions will be in "1" point increments for each item. Judges are allowed to take multiple deductions for the same item deduction found in multiple areas.



Again, thank you for selecting me as your Publication Officer and remember, please email me your pictures, articles, and information by the 15th of the month so it can be included in your Newsletter.


