DBCC GENERAL MEETING MINUTES DATE: 2-2-23

Call to Order: Time: 7:32 pm by Dave Peck at the Discovery Bay Yacht Club, Bilge Room

36 Members present. 3 Guests present

President's Report (Dave Peck): Dave started the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Vice President's Report (Shari): Guests tonight are: Craig (and Jackie) Daley – they have a new 2023 C8 70th Anniversary Edition, White with Black top. Also, Kim and Heather Sloat – they have a 2018 C7 Z06, White.

Treasurer's Report (Brian Enbom): (not present) Dave reported the bank account balance. Dues and other club expenses can be paid via Venmo. There are 45 members (families) in the Club as of mid-January.

Secretary's Report (Bill Montgomery): Please sign the sign-in sheet. Call for approval of last meeting minutes from the January 5th meeting (see January Newsletter). Motion to approve made by Shari P. and seconded by Rick W. All in favor – yes. Anyone opposed? No. Motion approved and carried.

Events Report (Karen Murphy): February: Dutra Museum Rio Vista and lunch at Peter's in Isleton on the 4th **March:** Sunday March 5th – Sacramento Underground Tour w/Lunch at Rio Café – cost is \$18pp, (Rick and Lisa Williams to lead). Also possible Potluck/Game night at the Yacht Club on March 11th.

Tim put out some blank applications for members to pick up after the meeting tonight

Sunshine Report (Open): Connie has resigned. This position is open. Snacks for February Meeting are: Mary H., Karen D., and Jenifer M. Snacks for March meeting will be: TBD. (Connie previously sent around a snack list signup for 2023.) All Birthdays for January, February and March were announced.

NCM Ambassador Report (Dave Gatt): Dave shared his knowledge of the new 2024 Corvette E-Ray, a hybrid with electric motors on the front wheels and the LT2 gas engine driving the rear wheels, and has a combined horsepower of 655hp, 160hp more than the base Stingray. The E-Ray has the fastest 0-60 time of any Corvette at 2.5sec. Dave also mentioned the pricing, which will start at about \$104K.

Dave also mentioned that through a variety of modifications, he has achieved .2 second off his own C8 0-60sec time, so his times went from 2.8 sec to 2.6 sec; very close to the E-Ray.

Dave said not to expect an all-electric Corvette, at least not in the current C8 frame/body style configuration. **Board Member at Large Report (Ed O'Brien):** Ed is looking for a place for the next Inaugural in 2023. See the update under Events above.

Old Business: 2023 Inaugural in November (see notes under Events above). Need to find a replacement for Connie as Sunshine Person. Looking for a volunteer.

New Business: None.

Close: 50/50 Raffle: Won by Rick Williams (\$80, split 50/50, so Rick get \$40) Motion to close by Shari Peck., 2nd by Carl Guth. Motion approved and carried.
