

**Call to Order:** Time: 7:31pm by Dave Peck at the Discovery Bay Yacht Club, Bilge Room. 36 Members present. Zero Guests present.

**President's Report (Dave Peck):** Dave started the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. Dave said that Sandy Ramos has volunteered to do Sunshine for the rest of the year.

Vice President's Report (Shari): Two new memberships tonight are: (1) Jackie and Craig Daley. They have a 2023 70th Anniversary Edition C8 with Lambo Doors. Also, (2) Kim Sloat and Heather Oddy. They have a 2018 White Z06. These new members were presented their membership packages tonight and photos were taken.

**Treasurer's Report (Brian Enbom):** Brian reported the bank account balance (see BOD Minutes for amount)





**Secretary's Report (Bill Montgomery):** Please sign the sign-in sheet. Call for approval of last meeting minutes from the March 2nd meeting (see March Newsletter). Motion to approve made by Mary Hodel and seconded by Rick Williams. All in favor – yes. Anyone opposed? No. Motion approved and carried. Minutes were passed as published

Dave mentioned that the C9 will probably be a gas engine (newly designed 6th generation engine), mid-engine car (not electric). Still too early to know for sure. Corvette brand to probably extend to a sedan and a SUV.


