DBCC GENERAL MEETING MINUTES DATE: 9-7-23

Call to Order: Time: 7:34pm by Dave Peck at the Discovery Bay Yacht Club, Bilge Room. 42 Members present. 0 Guest present.

President's Report (Dave Peck): Dave started the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance. New BOD members for 2024-2025 will be nominated at the end of this meeting. Terms are for 2 years. Nominations remain open until the end of October. Honor Bar – Bar upstairs to be used by DBCC members for now until we get someone RBS trained. Club will pay for training. See the standing rules for further details. Ed spoke about the Inaugural on November 11th. The theme will be Red/White/Blue. Doors open at 6pm with dinner at 7pm. Costs are: Steak dinner is \$68pp, and Chicken dinner is \$61pp if paid by October 20, 2023. Each meal is already subsidized by the Club at \$50 each. For payments on or after October 21, 2023, the Steak dinner is \$93pp and the Chicken dinner is \$86pp and therefore those meals are only subsidized \$25 each.






