DBCC GENERAL MEETING MINUTES/ORDER OF BUSINESS DATE: 4-3-2025

Call to Order: Time: 7:35 pm by Shari Peck at the Discovery Bay Yacht Club, Bilge Room, 24 Members present. 2 Guests present.

President's Report (Shari Peck): *Shari started the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance *New guests were introduced. They are Kevin and Carol Metcalf, and they own a 2024 White C8 Corvette and have lived in Discovery Bay for 21 years. (they submitted an application for membership this evening.)

Vice President's Report (Tim Denham) *Our Club is always looking for new memberships. *Tim discussed the recruiting cards that can be handed out to potential new members. Anyone in the Club can hand these out. * Tim briefly spoke of the NorCal Packard Club. They apparently have a brochure.



Treasurer's Report (Lisa Williams): *Lisa reported the amount of money in the account as \$13,977.04 (See BOD minutes for all amounts). *Lisa reported income at \$786.60 for last month. Expenses were \$3,239.15 which were mostly for the Chicken Ranch Inaugural and storage rental fees.

Secretary's Report (Bill Montgomery): *Be sure to sign the sign-up sheet. *There was a call for approval of the prior month's meeting minutes from the 3/6/25 meeting (see March's DiscoVette). Motion to approve both made by Mary Hodel and seconded by Ed O'Brien. Everyone was in favor. No one opposed it. Motion was approved and carried. *Standing Rules are updated, and the latest changes were approval at the recent Board meeting. They will be posted to our members only section on the Club Website. 


























The C8 Corvette ZR1 Will Pace the Indy 500!

With "the Greatest Spectacle in Racing" less than a month away, officials at IndyCar have just announced that the 2025 Chevrolet Corvette ZR1 will serve as the pace car during the 109th running of the Indianapolis 500. The twin-turbocharged monster will be the 22nd Corvette to have that honor since the nameplate's debut in 1953.

Pro Football Hall of Famer and two-time Daytime Emmy Award winner Michael Strahan will helm the ZR1 as the honorary driver ahead of the 33-car field at the start of the Indy 500 on Sunday, May 25. Strahan will have to be on his game that day, given that the ZR1 puts a ridiculous 1064 hp through its rear wheels. Luckily, the pace car will come outfitted with the optional carbon aero package, bringing upgraded dive planes, underbody strakes, and a larger rear wing that combine to generate over 1200 lbs of downforce.

"Chevrolet is proud that the 2025 Corvette ZR1, our fastest Corvette ever, will be the Official Pace Car for the 109th Running of the Indianapolis 500," said Scott Bell, global Chevrolet vice president. "With a top speed of 233 mph, the Corvette ZR1 is the perfect fit to lead the Indy 500 field to green."

"The race car-like performance of the Corvette ZR1 makes it the perfect car to pace the Indianapolis 500, and the distinctive sound of the Chevrolet V-8 engine will echo brilliantly inside the walls of IMS," IMS and Indycar President J. Douglas Boles said.

The ZR1 Pace Car is finished in Arctic White over Jet Black, offset by unique green and gold accents and the Indy 500 logo. The car also features a unique striping package, as well as some slick endplates on the rear wing. It's not the most extravagant Corvette we've seen take the pace lap, but it's certainly not the worst looking. There's simply no denying that it will be the fastest, however.










